

I'm going to the Pittsburgh Zoo & Aquarium!

There are a lot of exciting things to see and do!

Before our visit, we can look at the map online or print one out at: Zoo Map.

### **Entering the Zoo**









We will park in the parking lot and walk to the entrance. There is construction right now at the Zoo. I might see big machines that might make loud sounds. That is okay. It is important to be safe near construction. I will stay with my grown-ups.

Getting into the Zoo is a little different right now. The ticket booths are in a different place. We will walk up the trail or ride the elevator or escalator to get into the Zoo. There might be lines. That is okay.

If I need one, we can check out a **sensory bag** at the ticket booth – it has lots of tools to help me while I am visiting.

# Visiting Animals









I will stay with my family while I look at animals.

Staying on the pathways only will keep me safe. If I get away from my group, I can ask a Zoo employee for help. These staff members wear shirts with the Zoo logo and a name badge, and they also carry radios.

When I see the animals,
I might be excited! Loud
noises or fast movements
can startle animals. I will try
to **stay calm** and quiet when
I am around the animals.
Sometimes there might be
a lot of people waiting to
see an animal, I can wait my
turn to see the animals.

Some areas of the Zoo might **smell funny** or strong. Some animals might **make noises.** That is okay. It is okay to see, smell, and hear new things!

### At the Zoo









Some of the animals might not be outside when I'm looking for them. That's okay! I may go see a different animal instead. Maybe I can see them the next time I visit the Zoo.

Some places at the Zoo might be noisy. If it is too loud for me, I can ask to go to a **designated quiet place** to take a break.

There are restrooms and water fountains at the Zoo. Most of the restrooms have air hand dryers and can be noisy. Family restrooms are located at Jambo Grill, near Islands, or at Water's Edge.

At the Zoo I might want to eat. We can bring **food** from home or buy food at a Zoo restaurant.

## **Leaving the Zoo**









There are **gift shops** at the Zoo. I might not be able to buy something at the gift shop every time I visit.
That is okay.

When it is time to go home, we will take the **trail**, **escalator**, **or elevator** back down to the gates and head to our car. Everyone is proud of me when I follow the rules and have a good time at the Zoo!
